# Staph Positions

#### **SPL - Senior Patrol Leader**

The SPL runs troop meetings and activities. It is the highest youth leadership position.

#### **ASPL - Assistant Senior Patrol Leader**

### Job Description Sheet

The ASPL assists the SPL. If the SPL is not at a meeting or activity, the ASPL will take over. The ASPL needs to work closely with the SPL.

#### PL - Patrol Leader

## Job Description Sheet

The Patrol Leader leads a group of scouts, hosts patrol meetings, and keeps the members of their patrol informed.

#### **Quartermaster**

## Job Description Sheet

The Quartermaster keeps track of the troops' supplies, loads and unloads the troop trailer, and manages all of the supplies that are needed in the troop.

## **Troop Guide**

# **Job Description Sheet**

The Troop Guide helps ASM's with teaching basic skill scouts. They should set a good example for younger scouts. They do not work on Merit Badges.

#### Instructor

## Job Description Sheet

The Instructor teaches other scouts skills that can include outdoor activities and rank advancements.

# Chaplain's Aide

## Job Description Sheet

The Chaplain's Aide hosts prayers at campouts and troop events, such as Court of Honors.

## **Historian**

# Job Description Sheet

The Historian mainly gathers photos and makes a scrapbook by the end of his term.

## **Webmaster**

# Job Description Sheet

The Troop Webmaster manages and updates the troop website.

## **Scribe**

The Scribe takes manages things such as records and takes notes during PLC's.
